Forest Hills School District

Forest Hills Local School District is a public school district serving the southeasternmost area of Hamilton County, Ohio outside the city of Cincinnati. The district specifically serves approximately 7,600 students from Anderson Township and the village of Newtown. There are 1,008 staff members working for the district.

The Challenge

Need for Improved Safety Training

Forest Hills School District (FHSD) sought to transition from a workers' compensation pool to a self-insured model. While the financial benefits were substantial, the decision carried risks. A critical requirement for this transition was bolstering staff safety training to reduce workplace injuries and ensure compliance with regulatory standards.

Inefficiencies in Accident Reporting

Before adopting PublicSchoolWORKS, FHSD relied on a manual, paper-based accident reporting process. This approach not only demanded significant time from administrative staff but also opened the door for errors and delays in incident resolution.
